UPDATE

By the time you receive this letter, Ps. Stephen Sumrall, and the team from Feed the Hungry will have arrived in Rwanda. Over two weeks (8-17th Sept 2004), we will distribute 110,000kg of food and aid provided by you, the global partners and friends of Feed the Hungry.

“[In Rwanda] we will have nightly Crusades at Gitarama Stadium (believed to be the original starting location of the mob violence) and has a seating capacity of over 35,000 people.

We will have four nights of praying, worship and the preaching of the Gospel. We will have three “decision” tents where new believers will not only receive individual prayer, and Bibles, but church directories which guide them to a local congregations and list the many social and spiritual services available to them.

Three mornings of the crusades will begin with a pastor’s and leaders conference where they will be encouraged, refreshed, and equipped for their spiritual battle on the frontlines.

We will distribute massive quantities of rice, beans, corn, pasta, milk and other aid at 9 different locations including: Gitarama orphanage; Kiziba Refugee Camp at Kibuye, Rwanda; the AIDS-HIV Association; and at 6 different Churches where we will give out food to the poor, needy, widows, street children, and families that are in need.

We will visit the Children's Hospital, the Genocide Memoria, and we will also visit the Kigali Prison – holding facility of the very people used to commit murder during the attempted genocide ten years ago...

Please pray for us, and that God will be glorified and Thousands will come to know Jesus the Christ as Lord and Saviour”

FIELD REPORT VIDEO

A short video was produced and shown at the annual campmeeting held in Southbend Indiana, USA. It highlighted three projects of Feed the Hungry: Chennai in India, Honduras and Rwanda.

Chennai India’s outreach was the focal point of intense spiritual warfare where anti-Christian efforts tried to hinder and halt our planned outreach there. But God is faithful, and when the enemy’s efforts were exhausted the food supplies were safely delivered to their joyous reception. Once again the common person was overwhelmed that total strangers in a far-off and distant country would care enough to send them food.

One of our re-occurring projects to the nation of Honduras was brought to the attention of Mrs. Agua Ocana de Madura, the First Lady of Honduras. Mrs. Ocana de Madura was a Spanish born diplomat to the region before her marriage to the President of Honduras. She has a high intolerance of corruption and a passion to help the people of her adopted nation. In our twelfth outreach to the nation over five years since Hurricane Mitch, Mrs. Ocana de Madura requested a meeting with FTH to personally thank the ministry for the work being done in her nation. As Ps. Steve was introducing the video at the Campmeeting, he shared how he was prompted by the Spirit to encourage Mrs. Ocana de Madura. Ps. Steve was able to share with her that she was like a modern-day Esther – placed in a position of influence to help save a nation.
