

Thriving Through Faith



Priscilla lives in Bulenga, Uganda.

We first met her ten years ago. We want you to meet her too.

She lost both of her parents to AIDs before she was a month old. Not long after, she was diagnosed with AIDs herself. AIDs gives Priscilla a constant headache and a frequently paralyzed leg, causing her to limp.

Priscilla's aunt raised her alongside her five cousins. For years, the seven of them were cramped in a small house without beds, blankets or enough food. And then, ten years ago, life got so much better when they met Feed The Hungry. Every day since, Priscilla and her cousins have received one meal a day, through their school, provided by faithful friends like you.

Priscilla is now a beautiful 19-year-old. She still lives with her aunt, but is no longer in school. Each day she cleans and prepares breakfast, lunch and dinner for the entire household.

She had a job selling porridge until her boss could no longer afford to pay her. Since then, Priscilla has opened her own stand selling porridge and is hoping to expand her menu.

Priscilla still trusts God. She has always praised Him for His sacrifice and great love for her. She is a Sunday school teacher for kids 4-6 years old. She loves to tell them different Bible stories. Her favorite is the story of Solomon and his vast wisdom.

As a child, Priscilla longed for friendship but because of her AIDs, most of the other children would not come close to her. But you are her friend. You have come alongside Priscilla and helped her grow into the God-fearing, young woman she is today.

Knowing Priscilla has given us so much joy. We have watched her grow physically, mentally and in her faith in Jesus Christ. She is thriving today because of your kindness and generosity. You have blessed her. And if not her directly, someone precious and loved, much like her.

Pastor Mbabizi Rose heard of the great needs of the refugees in the Rwamwanja camp and came to help. She didn't know how God would use her until she saw how children with disabilities are often terribly neglected.

Most disabilities are not diagnosed and parents may not know how to properly care for a child who has a disability. Some parents leave their children on the street, unable to care for them any longer.

Pastor Rose heard God's call to take in every disabled child she came

across who had been thrown out on the street. Now, she is caring for 12 children with disabilities in a small mud-brick hut.

Another pastor in the community, who was a physiotherapist in the Congo, has come alongside Pastor Rose to work with the children. He provides therapy sessions for the children and is teaching some sign language.

All of the children are home-schooled and Pastor Rose has seen immense changes in each of them. Her children have epilepsy and

muscular paralysis, among other medical conditions – all of which have improved under her love and care.

Because of your generosity, Feed The Hungry provides meals for every child attending each of the 9 schools within the camp. With your help, we also provide meals for Pastor Rose's precious children as she homeschools them.

Every child is greatly loved by our Lord. Pastor Rose shows these children that great love every day. You do too. Thank you.
